Since I win or lose the contest based on number of downloads, I'm keeping track, heh. It doesn't end until the end of September though, so I have some time.

As soon as this quarter is over I will be outlining and writing a new book (I can't say the title yet, but it is a science fiction thriller), rewriting the dialogue for The Tale of Cloran Hastings, making a new movie for Xfire's summer movie contest and catching up on all the little things that I have been meaning to do but have not had time to because of my accursed classes.
